- The NPH Program offers comprehensive diagnostic and state-of-the-art treatment options for patients with NPH.
- The NPH Program team uses a variety of tests to help diagnose NPH, following guidelines developed by an international team of neurosurgeons. The guidelines were published in 2005 in *Neurosurgery*[®], the official journal of the Congress of Neurological Surgeons.
- Our program uses a multidisciplinary team approach and an exceptional staff with experts in neurology, neurosurgery, neuropsychology and physical therapy who hold monthly, interdisciplinary conferences where specialists review and discuss every case.
- Team members in the NPH Program are highly experienced in diagnosing and treating NPH. They combine their expertise to ensure patients receive the most comprehensive care possible. Team members include:
 - Neurologists — physicians with advanced training in the diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the brain, including memory disorders
 - Neurosurgeon — a physician who specializes in surgery on the brain, spine and other parts of the nervous system
 - Neuropsychologists — clinical psychologists with specialized training in the neurobehavioral aspects of brain disorders
 - Physical therapists — professionals who evaluate and improve movement and function of the body, such as physical mobility, balance, posture, fatigue and pain
 - Radiologists — physicians who specialize in creating and interpreting images of areas inside the body
- Using their combined expertise, advanced imaging and modern monitoring methods, our team of specialists offers the best answer for a treatment of NPH.
